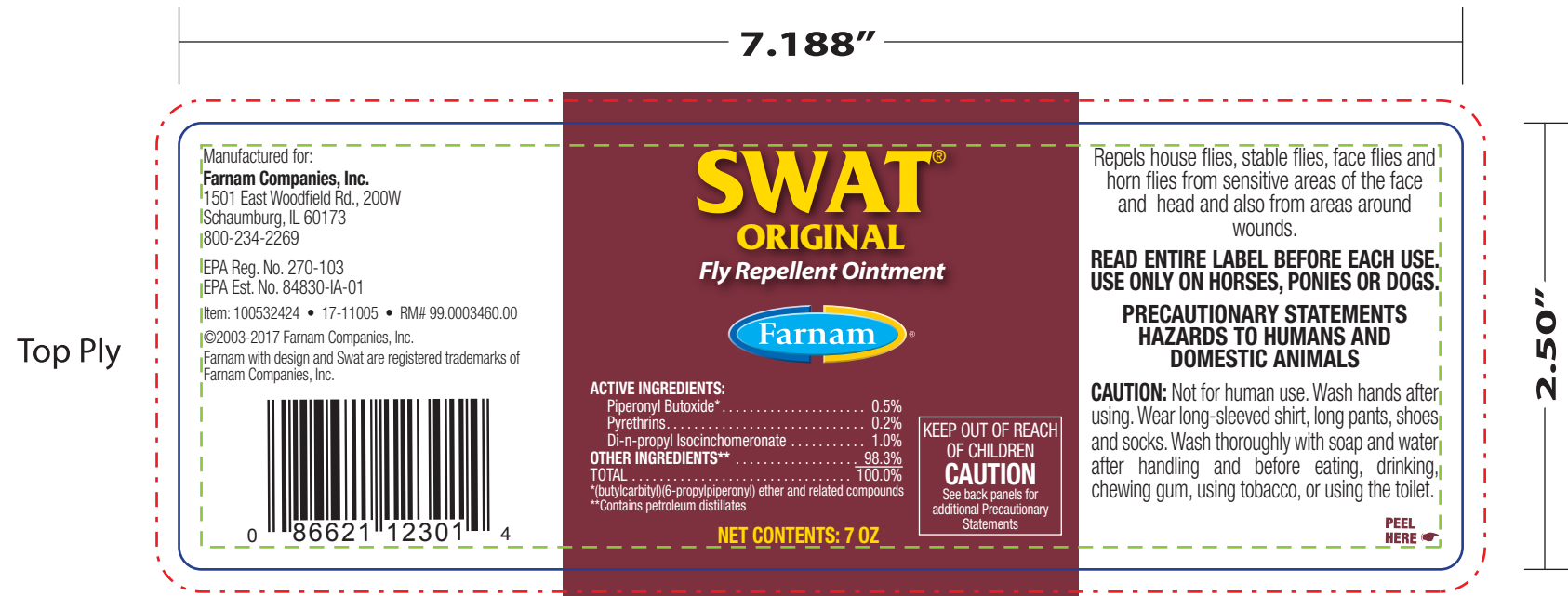

			4. If OP1 has full coverage graphics, bleed 1/16" to 3/32" onto OP2.
