DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product may be applied either as a spray or as a wipe. For horses, foals, sheep apply as a wipe using a piece of clean, absorbent cloth (woolens or acrylic) or sponge. Wear rubber gloves or mitt when applying as a wipe. Spray or wipe horse's entire body while standing against the leg of the stall to ensure adequate coverage. Avoid getting spray into horse's eyes, nose, or mouth. Application should be done for best results. Reapply every 7 to 7 days under normal conditions for initial applications. An protective barrier, reapply every 10 to 14 days as needed. Not reapply each time animal is washed or exposed to heavy rain.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:
